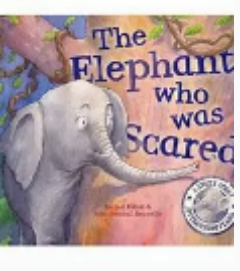
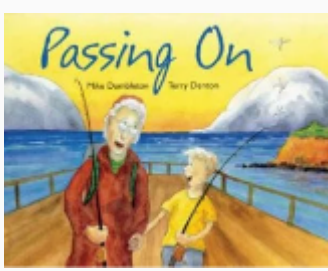
Reading about the real life story of a successful or remarkable person will influence, motivate, and provide encouragement to become a better person. Come in and browse our large range of inspirational books.
