Say G'day to Renee next time you visit!

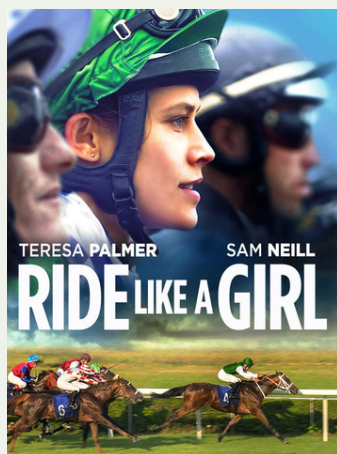

Because they have so many stories!



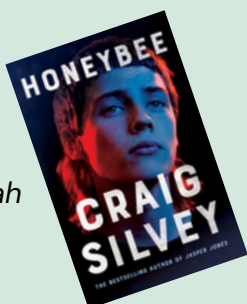
EVER WONDERED WHAT THE MOST POPULAR TITLES IN THE LIBRARY ARE?
