

## Management of Illegal Camping

Shire of Exmouth Rangers, Parks and Wildlife (DBCA) Rangers, Defence and the Australian Federal Police work together to regularly patrol all areas in Exmouth.

### Spanish

No está permitido acampar o dormir en su vehículo o caravana en la Comarca de Exmouth a menos que se aloje en un Parque de Caravanas, un camping oficial del Parque Nacional o en una propiedad privada con el consentimiento de los propietarios o residentes por un tiempo limitado.

Acampar incluye el uso de cualquier cosa portátil, como una tienda de campaña o un toldo, es decir, cualquier estructura temporal capaz de proporcionar refugio. Esto incluye todo tipo de vehículos, caravanas y autocaravanas.

Las sanciones por acampada ilegal son de 200AUD por persona encontrada acampando ilegalmente en Australia Occidental.

No está permitido aparcar en las reservas, alrededor de las pistas ovals, en los laterales de las carreteras, en las pistas ovals ni en los bordes de las carreteras, y podrá ser multado de acuerdo con la Ley Local de la Comarca de Exmouth.

### French

Il est interdit de camper ou de dormir dans son véhicule ou son camping-car dans le comté d'Exmouth, sauf si l'on séjourne dans un parc de caravanes, dans un camping officiel du parc national ou sur une propriété privée avec l'accord des propriétaires ou des résidents pour une durée limitée.

Le camping comprend l'utilisation de tout ce qui est portable, comme une tente ou un auvent, c'est-à-dire toute structure temporaire capable de fournir un abri. Cela inclut tous les types de véhicules, les caravanes et les camping-cars.

Les amendes pour camping illégal s'élèvent à 200 AUD par personne trouvée en train de camper illégalement en Australie occidentale.

Le stationnement est interdit dans les réserves, autour des pistes ovals, sur les côtés des routes, sur les pistes ovals ou sur les bords de route, et vous pouvez être condamné à une amende conformément à la loi locale du comté d'Exmouth.

### Chinese

埃克斯茅斯郡不允许在车辆/大篷车内露营或睡觉，除非您住在大篷车公园或经土地所有者/居民同意的私人土地上。

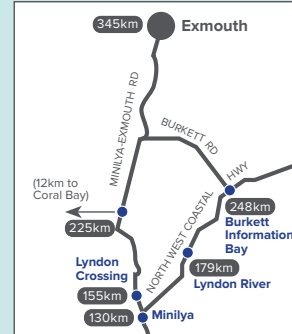
露营包括使用任何便携式的东西，如棚屋、帐篷或遮阳篷——基本上任何能够提供居住的临时建筑。它还包括车辆、大篷车和露营车。

在西澳大利亚州，非法露营的罚款为每人 200 美元。

禁止在保护区、椭圆形场地周围和路边停车，否则您可能会根据埃克斯茅斯郡地方法律被罚款。

# CAMPING within the SHIRE OF EXMOUTH

Camping or sleeping in your vehicle/caravan is not permitted in the Shire of Exmouth unless you are staying in a caravan park or on private property with the consent of the landowners/residents. This includes all state and national parks, local reserves, beaches, bush reserves and car parks.

Camping includes using anything portable like a shed, tent or awning – essentially any temporary structure capable of providing habitation. It also includes all vehicles, caravans and campervans.

If you are planning to come to Exmouth for a camping holiday, you need to book ahead as there is **no free camping in Exmouth**.

Under State Government legislation, camping is permitted only in designated caravan parks or camping grounds such as one of the licensed caravan parks or the Cape Range National Park. Penalties under the Caravan and Camping Regulations for illegal camping is \$200 per person found illegally camped within Western Australia.

**Please Note:** The closest 24-hour rest area is located OUTSIDE the Shire of Exmouth at Yannarie River, Lyndon River and Yalabia, so please plan your trip wisely to ensure you arrive safely in Exmouth. ## CARAVAN PARKS & NATIONAL PARK CAMPING LOCATIONS



## Parking

Parking is only permitted within marked bays within the Shire of Exmouth. Long bay parking is available in the town centre and at the Ningaloo Centre.

Parking on reserves, around ovals and on road sides is not permitted, and you could be fined under the Shire of Exmouth Local Law.

## Four-Wheel Driving

Drive slowly, respect conditions on the day and avoid driving at night. Always drive slowly on coastal off-road tracks and keep speed on beaches to 20km/h.

## Fire

A restricted burning period exists all year within the Shire of Exmouth. Fire permits are **REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES** for any open-air fires greater than 1m<sup>3</sup>. Permits must be obtained from the Shire of Exmouth on **08 9949 3000**.

Lighting of fires in the open air within the Shire of Exmouth for the purpose of camping or cooking is prohibited on days of High, Extreme or Catastrophic fire danger forecast (this includes gas cooking appliances).

## Beach Emergency Signs (BEN)

Beach Emergency Number (BEN) signs are installed at most beaches in Exmouth.

The BEN system is a unique coding system designed to improve emergency response times.

You can guide emergency services to a specific location using the unique Beach Emergency Number (BEN) on the signs. **In an emergency, dial 000** and quote the unique code and location information on the BEN sign. Where possible, someone should wait at the BEN sign until the emergency service arrives.
